2. From this point you can get a brilliant view of the Falkirk Wheel. If you are lucky you might even see the Kelpies far away in the distance.



3. The 150m tunnel ahead of you was built under the archaeological remains of the Antonine Wall and above abandoned mine works.

4. The Union Canal is connected to the Forth and Clyde Canals by the impressive Falkirk Wheel. This is a good spot to see some wildlife so stop and take a moment.

5. Rough castle is one of the many forts on the Antonine wall. It is about a 20 minute walk from the Wheel and a great extra to our trail.



1. The Falkirk Wheel is the only rotating boat lift in the World. Start the trail here by exploring the Visitor Centre and booking your sailing on the Wheel itself.

6. The play park also known as the Irn Bru park. It's a good place to play and relax before finishing your trip with a visit to the café.
